

Clyde Yancy, MD, MSc is Chief, Cardiology, Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine and Associate Director, The Bluhm Cardiovascular Institute at Northwestern Memorial Hospital. Until recently he was the Medical Director at Baylor Heart and Vascular Institute and Chief of Cardiothoracic Transplantation at Baylor University Medical Center. He co-chairs the Coalition to Reduce Racial and Ethnic Disparities in Cardiovascular Outcomes sponsored by the American College of Cardiology (ACC).
