Climb for a Cure

Climb for a Cure is Fight CRC's largest fundraising event. Founded in 2016 and what began with just 12 participants and raising \$500, has evolved into a flagship fundraising event for Fight Colorectal Cancer, with hundreds of participants and over \$1 million raised.

Every year since 2016, relentless champions join Climb for a Cure to connect with and honor fellow survivors and caregivers and remember the loved ones lost to colorectal cancer. Climb for a Cure pushes our community to new heights together while raising vital funds and awareness toward finding a cure.

Each year, funds from Climb for a Cure support <u>Collaborative Group of the Americas on Inherited Gastrointestinal Cancer (CGA-IGC)</u> with a research grant focusing on patients with inherited colorectal cancer syndromes, familial colorectal cancer, and early onset colorectal cancer (EAO), as well as Fight CRC's <u>Path to a Cure</u>.
