

In March 2025, our community made history. A record-breaking 314 advocates from 40 states turned the National Mall blue and brought their stories straight to the steps of Congress — making this the largest Call-on Congress to date. These advocates didn't just raise their voices — they gave their time. They showed up to fight for something bigger: More research, more treatment options, more awareness — more time.

As one of our partners, BeastRob, put it,

"We took to Capitol Hill—sharing our stories, demanding action, and urging legislators to protect funding for colorectal cancer research, the second-leading cause of cancer-related deaths in the U.S. We refuse to stay silent. We will continue to fight for our mothers, fathers, sisters, brothers, aunts, uncles, and every life impacted by this preventable disease."

This March, we proved what's possible when advocates come together with urgency and heart. We're not just raising awareness — we're rewriting the future of this disease. And we won't stop until everyone impacted by colorectal cancer has the time they deserve.





UNITING TO IMPROVE CANCER CARE

The Colorectal Cancer Care Initiative (CRCCI) is the first major effort to respond to a critical gap in colorectal cancer care. In March we launched a workgroup and hosted a webinar in partnership with STAT news.

POLICY GROUP:

As part of the CRCCI, Fight CRC launched a workgroup of more than 30 advocacy, physician and industry leaders dedicated to preserving access to screening. The group came together in response to Braidwood v. Kennedy, a Supreme Court case that threatens patient access to no-cost cancer screening. In an ever-changing policy landscape, having a united community is more important than ever. This group will continue to work together to ensure all patients have access to life-saving care.




