Overarching Goal: Develop and begin to execute a unified global research strategy addressing the rise of early onset colorectal cancer.

Scope:

The focus of this meeting was established with direction from our international advocacy and patient community to examine the etiology of early onset colorectal cancer.

We recognize there are many critical areas of concern for our research community in early age onset of colorectal cancer such as: developing screening programs or addressing screening guidelines but the meeting will be dedicated to discussion of global etiology.

Meeting Objectives

1. **Research Community:** Develop connections and unity among the global research community working on EOCRC.
2. **Understand Drivers:** Deepen our understanding of the suspected etiologic drivers of EOCRC based on research in each of the represented regions.
3. **Launch Initiative:** Launch an initiative and post-conference workgroups to determine a way forward to support this work. Create workgroup charters and identify members. We anticipate the following workgroups:
 - **Scientific Research Themes:** Identify the areas of etiological research that need to be prioritized and begin conducting the research.
 - **Epidemiology Tools:** Recommend etiologic standardized epidemiology tools and other tools needed to implement research studies (e.g. databases, etc.)
 - **Biobanking:** Identify recommended standards for blood biobanking and tissues.
 - **Fundraising:** Identify funding strategies to support the initiative.
 - **Other Topic:** A topic to be identified by the workshop attendees.
